There is a strong emphasis on education, the development of educational resources, and supporting system changes that improve perioperative care.

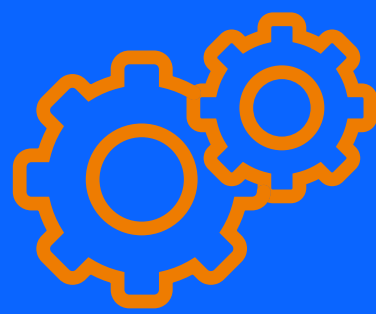

- There are places for August 2022

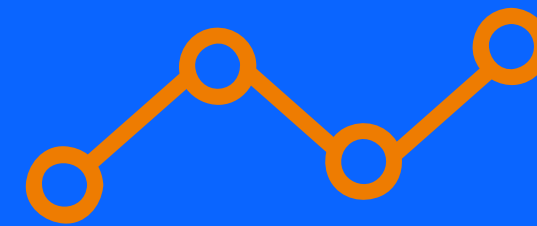
